



CARRY OVER SOUNDS TO PHRASES WITH VISUALS

I love using 100 Trials for Speech to try to get a whole lot of repetitions and practices of speech targets in one session. If you're new to the idea of 100 trials, then I will share some tips on how I use them in my sessions.


**PREPARATION:** These look great printed on color paper! For durability purposes, I like to laminate them or place inside sheet protectors.

**STORAGE:** These can be placed in a folder with plastic sleeves so that you can choose the page. Many of them are themed, but you don't have to stick to the themes. Kids enjoy them either way! I have also laminated them and clipped them on a ring binder.


**USE WITH:** dabbers, counters, mini erasers, whiteboard markers, magnetic counters + wand or color the pictures in to mark them off. I prefer using dice to encourage high repetitions.


**TO PLAY:** Each line is broken down into a set of 10. Sometimes I let the child complete the whole page - or - we split it in half and see how can reach the end of their 5 lines (50 repetitions) first. You can always have the child say their target words for YOUR pictures too!






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
